## III. OLD BUSINESS

Western Regional Examining Board (WREB)

The commission heard a presentation from Dr. Bruce Horn, Dr. Mark Christensen and Sharon Osborn-Popp, PhD on behalf of the Western Regional Examining Board (WREB). The presentation provided an overview of the WREB examination and the changes that will be taking effect in January 2018. The Commission also heard comments from Peter Arsenault D.M.D. from Tufts University School of Dental Medicine and from David Perkins, DMD on behalf of the Commission on Dental Competency Assessments (CDCA).

No further action was taken regarding the Commission's September 6, 2017 decision that the WREB examination will not be accepted for licensure for applicants who take the examination after January 1, 2018.

Dr. Banwell made a motion, seconded by Dr. Reiss, to approve the Consent Order which imposes a \$2500.00 civil penalty. The motion passed with all in favor. Dr. Strathearn signed the Order.

C. <u>Steven Stirbl, DMD – Petition No. 2015-1279</u>

David Tilles, Staff Attorney, Department of Public Health presented a Consent Order in this matter. Attorney Cynthia Coccomo was present on behalf of respondent.

Dr. Katz made a motion, seconded by Dr. Reiss, to approve the Consent Order which imposes a reprimand a probation for a period of six months. The motion passed with all in favor. Dr. Strathearn signed the Order.
