The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of this project is to replace several structures of the bridge, such as the access ladders, upper platforms, and guy wires on the two tall towers, on the Saugatuck River Railroad Bridge.

Right-of-way impacts are not associated with the proposed project.

Construction is anticipated to begin in 2025. The estimated construction cost for this project is projected to be about \$5 million, with 100% state funds.
