The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of this project is to address the deficiencies identified in the CTDOT Bridge Inspection Report affecting Bridge No. 00448—improving the condition, extending the service life of the bridge, and providing safe travel conditions for all facility users.

Right-of-way impacts will be minimal. Some easements may be required for the construction of the bus facilities and multi-use trail.

Construction is expected to start in fall 2026, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$6.4 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
