The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community the opportunity to learn about the proposed project and to allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

This project is to improve pedestrian safety by removing the slip lanes at the interchange, reducing the number and length of pedestrian crossings. Sidewalks will also be added on both sides of Route 99, connecting the existing sidewalks to address the existing gap in the pedestrian network within the project limits.

Right-of-way impacts are not anticipated.

Construction is anticipated to begin in spring of 2027, based on the availability of funding, acquisition of rights-of-way acquisition, and approval of permits. The estimated construction cost is \$6 million. This project is anticipated to be undertaken with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
