Mr. Slivinski.

Members of an interview team from The Card Home for the Aged Inc. met with you on December 19<sup>th</sup> 2024 along with your case manager Jessica Michaud from United Services. As at the time you were informed your rent would be \$3,071.00. At that time you told us a Title 19 application had been sent on your behalf to the State Of Connecticut for residency at the Card Home.

During these past three months since your entry on February 4<sup>th</sup> 2025, The Card Home has made several attempts to support you in your residency here. There have been documented incidents with staff members.

On April 11, 2025 we learned from your case manager David Carlson (United Services) that the application has still not been completed or sent to the state.

As of April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025, you have not paid your monthly room, board and service in full. Your amount of arrears as of May 22<sup>nd</sup> is \$ 8,496.00.

For June 1<sup>st</sup> your new arrears total will be \$10,620

Please consider this formal notice that The Card Home for the Aged Inc. is discharging you as a resident for failure to meet financial obligations effective June 22<sup>nd</sup> 2025.

Pursuant to the application, and the agreement of entrance you signed on February 4th 2025. Your failure to comply with The Card Home rules and regulations is a concern for us. The Card Home is an inappropriate placement to meet your needs.

You have the right to request a hearing and to appeal this discharge. You and your representative can request a hearing. The law allows you ten days to begin the appeal process (19a-535a (d)).
