The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of the project is to replace the existing structure and provide a structure that is in a state of good repair, improving safety for all roadway users.

The right-of-way impacts associated with the proposed improvements are in the form of slope easements and construction easements.

Construction is anticipated to begin spring 2027 based on the availability of funding, acquisition of rights of way, and approval of permit(s). The estimated construction cost for this project is approximately \$3 million. This project is anticipated to be undertaken with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
