The purpose of the project is to raise the superstructure of Bridge No. 02708 to ensure recreational access and use from Plum Bank Creek.

Right-of-way impacts are not anticipated.

Construction is expected to start in 2028, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$3.4 million with 100% state funds.
