Notice of Public Information Meeting

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (Department) will conduct a Public Information Meeting concerning a proposed Road Diet (roadway reconfiguration) on U.S. Route 1 in Fairfield on Wednesday Wednesday, June 17, 2020 at 7 p.m. The meeting will be discussing a proposed road diet on U.S. Route 1 (Post Road) between Rennell Drive and 250 feet east of North/South Pine Creek Road, a distance of 1.01 miles. The formal presentation will begin at 7:00 p.m.

A "road diet" is a reconfiguration of roadway markings to allow better bicycle and pedestrian access and safety. A presentation will be given to explain the proposed work followed by a question and answer session. The meeting will be held virtually using a Microsoft Teams Meeting link.
