The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

Originally constructed in 1956, the bridge has exceeded its design lifespan and will be replaced with a new bridge in accordance with CTDOT and FHWA design standards.

Right-of-way impacts are anticipated as part of this project.

Construction is expected to start spring 2029, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisitions, and permits. The estimated cost is \$5 million with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
