1. Call to order & Seating of voting members

2. Minutes – August 3, 2023

A motion was made and seconded to approve the $\frac{1}{4}$ meeting minutes and the motion was approved unanimously.

3. State Drought Coordinator Report

Becca Dahl mentioned that she had distributed summaries of January, February, and March data and provided a brief recap of conditions. Recap highlighted the abnormally wet conditions throughout the winter months and through March. Expecting relatively normal conditions over the next two weeks. No recommendation or motion made to adopt any drought stages.

4. Business

Becca provided an overview of the recent meeting among agency staff, to continue planning for an upcoming drought tabletop exercise. The group recommends the exercise take place in early 2025 to accommodate scheduling conflicts for some of the involved agencies. Martin noted potential legislative conflicts in early 2025. Becca explained the goals of the Drought Tabletop Exercise, which include testing the higher stages of the State Drought Response Plan.
