

Minutes of Regular Meeting

A Regular Meeting of the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority was convened on Wednesday, June 4, 2025 at 9:02 a.m., concerning the following:

Chairman Gillett convened the meeting, and asked PURA's general counsel Scott Muska to summarize the Resolution Authorizing Settlement. Commissioner Arconti moved for approval; Commissioner Caron seconded. The vote in favor by the three commissioner panel assigned to this docket and being present was unanimous.

2. Docket No. 21-09-17 – PURA Investigation into Medium and Heavy-Duty Electric Vehicle Charging – Interim (GAC/dc)

Chairman Gillett asked PURA technical staff Danielle Chaloux to summarize the Interim Decision. Commissioner Arconti moved for approval; Commissioner Caron seconded. The vote in favor by the three commissioner panel assigned to this docket and being present was unanimous.
