OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Applications for Review:
 - a. Bryan Royster HTG.0412876-D2
 - Appeared before the Board on 7-18-24. The Board recommended that he completes one more year of apprenticeship. The applicant has submitted email from DOL for review.
 - ii. Board Member Foster moved to approve the applicant sit for the D2 exam. Board Member Higgins seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
 - b. Brandon Oakes HTG.0413784-S7
 - i. Appeared before the Board on 7-31-23. Board approved for S-8 exam at this meeting. The applicant has held S-8 since 2-26-24.
 - ii. The applicant has submitted an S-7 application and is seeking approval for S-7 exam, as he has equivalent experience due to having held a P-1 Unlimited Contractor license in good standing since 4-20-22.
 - iii. Board Member Foster moved to approve the applicant sit for the S7 exam. Board Member Davenport seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- 2. Update on the transition from the Certified Employee Training Program (CETP) to the PERC Education Program (PEP)

- 3. Update on CT Apprenticeship Program (D2 and/or S2) with Local 30 Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee (JATC) discussion
 - a. In depth discussion regarding the differences between NY and CT apprenticeship programs and what updates they've made to the curriculum for the CT program. Local 30 is looking for Board approval of their proposed curriculum.
 - b. The Board inquired whether they would have on-the-job training hours as a part of the curriculum.
 - c. The Board also inquired how apprentices will get installation training in this program.
 - d. Chairman Barrieau requested a breakdown of how many S2/D2 licensees they have in CT.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Aiello Home Services Keith Miller License
 - a. Previously, Aiello applied to have Keith Miller as the contractor of record, but was denied as they are listed as the contractor of record for a company in North Carolina.
 - b. Mr. Steiner is before the board on behalf of Aiello to request that Keith Miller be accepted as a contractor of record. Aiello does currently have a contractor of record but would like to have Mr. Miller as a backup contractor of record.
 - c. The Board noted concerns that Mr. Miller would not be able to be active in the business and overseeing jobs while living full-time in North Carolina.
 - d. The Board stated that they will not provide pre-approval, but if the situation arises Aiello would need to come before the board for review. And that they will need to review this further with DCP Legal.
