- Commissioner Galvin moved to approve AAL.1463 on the condition that they submit a more detailed overview of the course. Commissioner Hawkins seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- Commissioner Moore discussed his concerns with AAL.1449, noting there were errors throughout the course presentation. Commissioner Galvin moved to accept AAL.1449 under the condition that they submit a new presentation with the corrected slides. Commissioner Hawkins seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- Commissioner Galvin moved to accept all remaining courses (AAL.1336, AAL.1446-1448, AAL.1450-AAL.1454, AAL.1456-AAL.1462, AAL.1464-APR.395) with the exception of AAL.1455. It was determined that the course content for AAL.1455 is not acceptable as it was primarily focused on business skills and fees. Commissioner Lineaweaver seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

## **COMMENTS OR CONCERNS OF ANY PERSON PRESENT TODAY**

- The Commission began discussing an approval process for equivalent credit for Valuation Courses that DCP can enact internally.
  - Commissioner Lineaweaver moved to allow the department approve the following equivalent credit requests without requiring Commission review. Valuation Courses: 2A, 2B and 3 would receive 18-hour credit, 1A and 1B would receive 10-hour credit. Commissioner Galvin seconded the motion. After further discussion Commissioner Lineaweaver revoked her motion.
- The commission began discussion on whether CT will accept credit for the mandatory 7-Hour National Valuation Bias and Fair Housing Laws and Regulations course for a CT licensee that completes the course for an out of state license. DCP's Debbie Yanosy noted that it would be accepted.
- Jason Cohen noted that Debbie Yanosy has completed 3 years with DCP and Jeffrey Mosher has completed his 6-month probationary period. And congratulated them for their service.
- Debbie Yanosy noted that the Department has received approval to begin developing a list of Appraisers open to supervising new provisional licensees.
- Commissioner Galvin asked for guidance on how to handle active provisional licensees that are active duty/reservists.
- Jaqueline Beauchaine inquired if the slides should be updated with the current status of the audit. The Commission noted that they do not feel like it is necessary at this time.

## **ADJOURNMENT**

Commissioner Hawkins moved to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Rivera seconded the motion. The motion passed and the meeting was adjourned at 9:56 am.
