Minutes Review

- Review of the previous meeting minutes, February 10, 2026.
 - Board Member Dahn moved to approve the minutes as presented. Board Member Doane seconded the motion. The motion passed (8-0-1) Abst: Mattern.

1. Reconsideration Approve CL 4 License

- Moormann holds a Bachelor’s in Architecture and a Master’s in Civil Engineering. The Board previously denied his reciprocity request due to a lack of a qualifying engineering undergraduate degree.
 - Discussion:
 - Multiple members noted his education lacked the breadth of core engineering coursework
 - His professional experience was acknowledged as substantial, but there was debate whether experience could overcome academic gaps
 - The applicant provided extensive commentary on his practice, licensure in several states and graduate level education.
 - Board Member Szweczak moved to table the review for Moormann and suggests that Mr. Moormann request an NCEES evaluation. Board Member Lewandowski seconded the motion. The motion passed (6-0-1) Abst: DeWolf.

- Svolto has an undergraduate degree in GeoScience and a Master’s in Engineering. The Board previously denied the application due to a lack of a qualifying engineering undergraduate degree.
 - Discussion:
 - Members stressed the lack of engineering fundamentals in a science degree
 - NCEES evaluation was submitted, but some members questioned the reliability of the review. Noting that engineering economics and seminars were counted as engineering coursework.
 - Significant debate arose regarding consistency of these reviews
 - Some members discussed tabling until a general policy update, others agreed that the decision should stand
 - Board Member DeWolf moved to sustain the Boards previous education evaluation and deny reciprocity for Svolto due to the lack of a qualifying undergraduate engineering degree. Board Member Szewczak seconded the motion. The motion passed (6-1-0).
- Tronci had previously been approved to sit for exams and holds a foreign civil engineering degree evaluated by NCEES
 - Discussion:
 - NCEES evaluation shows about 40.8 engineering credits, the board questioned the fractional credit but agreed the degree was equivalent.
 - The Board acknowledged that they had already vetted the applicants background in 2016 and found him qualified to sit for the exam.
 - Board Member DeWolf moved to approve Tronci. Board Member Regina seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

2. Reconsideration of Permit Class 1 Exam -Credit Part 1

- The applicant holds a BS in Physics from Japan and a Master’s in Electrical and Computer Engineering from UMass. NCEES evaluation indicated equivalency, but the Board previously denied based on their policy requiring an undergraduate engineering degree.

- Discussion:
 - There was significant debate about whether her combined degrees should qualify. Some members noted that her master’s coursework may cover the necessary engineering materials.
 - The applicant requested advice on what courses she should take to meet the requirements. This discussion led to having UMass determine equivalency to their ABET-accredited undergraduate curriculum.

- Board Member DeWolf moved to sustain the Boards previous decision and deny the application for Karwowski due to a lack of qualifying undergraduate degree.
 - The motion was not seconded after discussion.

- Board Member Lewandowski moved to table the review and advised the applicant to request an equivalency review of a 4-year accredited undergraduate degree in electrical and computer engineering at UMass. Board Member Regina seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Reconsideration of Permit Class 1 Exam -Credit Parts 1 & 2 Approve CL 1 License

- Chairman D’Andrea noted that he would like to schedule a special meeting to continue discussion on their review process.
 - The Board agreed that they need to clarify its policy for evaluating non-traditional education paths especially:
 - Science degrees with a Master’s in Engineering
 - Architecture degrees with engineering graduate work
 - Evaluate the weight of their reliance on NCEES evaluations
 - When does experience compensate for academic deficiencies?
 - A special meeting will take place on April 21st at 8:00am

- Board Member Dahn asked if a surveyor is required to keep a signed and sealed copy of every plan they produce.
 - Chairman D'Andrea responded that their office researched the issue and reached the same conclusion that there is no explicit requirement in statute or regulations stating that a retained copy must be the signed and sealed version. He also noted the following:
 - Common-sense expectations still apply
 - If a firm prepares a survey, it is assumed that the firm retains access to the survey documentation
 - Responsibility does not vanish if the signer is deceased
 - If the original signer is no longer available, another qualified licensee within the firm may, after appropriate due diligence, sign the survey if it ever needs to be reissued.

Board Member Regina moved to adjourn. Board Member Szewczak seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously, and the meeting adjourned at 11:01 am.
