Minutes Review

- Review of the previous meeting minutes, April 21, 2026.
 - Board Member Doane moved to approve the minutes as presented. Board Member DeWolf seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

- Policy regarding educational requirements
 - The Board aimed to clarify and modernize criteria for evaluating applicants whose academic paths don't neatly match ABET accredited engineering degrees, while ensuring:
 - Consistency
 - Fairness
 - Flexibility
 - Protection of the public
 - Science Degree and Master's in Engineering
 - The focus was on establishing consistent treatment for applicants with:
 - A non-engineering science bachelor's, plus
 - A master's in engineering, plus
 - Additional engineering coursework or experience.
 - The Board agreed that these applicants may be considered — but only with adequate engineering coursework.
 - A minimum of 48 engineering credit hours (the ABET education standard) should be required.
 - The 48 credits must be:
 - Engineering credits, not science substitutes.
 - Board-acceptable — meaning the Board must be able to review the substance.
 - Not “double-counted” (e.g., repeating undergraduate coursework within a master's program).
 - It was noted that the phrase “acceptable to the Board” needs to remain in the updated policy to allow for flexibility.

- Master’s or PhD for Experience Credit
 - The Board reaffirmed:
 - Master’s degree = 1 year of experience credit
 - PhD = 2 years of experience credit
 - This applies regardless of whether the degree was full-time or part-time, as long as coursework was completed while the applicant was gaining acceptable engineering experience.

- Foreign Degrees:
 - If NCEES deems the foreign degree ABET-equivalent:
 - Applicant is evaluated under Class 1
 - Experience requirements match those of domestic applicants
 - Master’s/PhD experience credits also apply

 - If NCEES deems the foreign degree “not equivalent”:
 - Generally considered a non-starter, unless:
 - Deficiencies are minor, or
 - Applicant later completed appropriate U.S. engineering master’s coursework to remedy deficiencies.

- The Board made no final rule changes but reached agreement on:
 - Principles to incorporate into updated evaluation guidelines.
 - Keeping flexibility while adding structure.

- Board Member Regina will draft a consolidated policy to refine and discuss at a future meeting.
