Comments or Concerns

- Board Member Mattern provided an update on her efforts to modernize and clarify the land surveyor application process. She noted that she and DCP staff are working on making recommendations for statute changes that are in line with DCP requirements.
 - Board Member Mattern emphasized the need to align statutes with actual practice and improve transparency for applicants.
 - She also contacted Bob Baron (President of CALS) and Bud Harvey (attorney and surveying educator) to coordinate efforts on updating the Land Surveying Statute Book.
 - Engineering board members were invited to participate in the upcoming legal meeting to ensure alignment across disciplines.
- Ryan Thompson raised a concern regarding unauthorized surveying activity:
 - A hydrographer, not licensed as a land surveyor, altered and submitted a survey map to DEEP. The altered map was used to challenge the as-built survey, despite being unlicensed and based on unverified data. He noted that DEEP accepted the altered document, raising concerns about agency awareness and enforcement.

- Ryan emphasized the growing issue of unlicensed individuals performing survey-like work (e.g., drone or hydrographic surveys) and submitting it to regulatory agencies.
- Board Member Thompson called for:
 - Stronger enforcement mechanisms against unlicensed practice.
 - Education for agencies like DEEP on the importance of verifying licensure.
 - Legislative or regulatory updates to address these recurring issues.
- Chairman D’Andrea and Janita Hamel (DCP Investigations) encouraged Ryan to file a formal complaint through the DCP Complaint Center to initiate an investigation.

Adjournment

Board Member Regina moved to adjourn. Board Member Szewczak seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously, and the meeting adjourned at 10:15 am.
